

Content of the Blackboard (All) Student Tab:

- Front page (once logged in) – Calendar, personal information, change password, etc.
- “Students” Tab / Modules
 - Classes: Quick View
 - *This will show in which classes (and organizations) you are currently enrolled.*
 - College Links
 - *Great place to find information on popular colleges.*
 - Calculator
 - *Basic calculator – interactive on the screen*
 - My Calendar
 - *Displays calendar events for the classes (and organizations) in which you are a member.*
 - Senior Project Resources
 - *Resources include: citation generators, research tips, DACC Senior Project binder (w/timeline, project details).*
 - “Hot Links” content
 - *Bureau of Labor Statistics, DACC online catalog, infOhio Resource (including a link to “Ask, Act, & Achieve”, Kuder, Ohio ORC , School Tube, and You Tube for Schools.*
 - Dictionary
 - *Opens a new window to “Dictionary.com” to search for definition of words.*
- “My Places” – Edit Notification Settings
- Content area layout (in “My Places” or “Classes: Quick View”)
 - Announcements
 - *Daily or weekly announcements posted by the instructor (may include links to other areas of the class environment).*
 - Assessments
 - *Assessment posted by instructor – tests, quizzes, projects, online/interactive assessment, etc.*
 - Assignments
 - *Information on daily, weekly, or project assignment. May include attachments or files needed to complete an assignment.*
 - Calamity Day
 - *Area in Blackboard where assignment information will be posted for special days (i.e. – calamity days, School-to-Career Days, etc.)*
 - Course materials
 - *Sources, references, or information needed to complete assignments or projects (i.e. – PowerPoints, links, files, documents, other media)*
 - Discussion

- *Forum where students and teachers can communicate and share thoughts on a given topic. Teachers can post a “discussion Topic” and students can respond to teacher and share thoughts with other students by threading his or her comments.*
- Tools – specific in each class
 - *Additional useful tools for the classroom environment. Including the following:*
 - Blogs – This tool is similar to the “Discussion Board” as far as a communication tool.
 - Tasks – This tool is like a “Things To Do” list. Once selected – a “Create Class Task” option will appear and you proceed as above for other options (blogs, discussion board, announcement, etc.).
 - Calendar – This tool is to keep a class or organization calendar.
 - User Manual – This tool accesses the BB user manual.
 - Discussion Board – Same as “Discussion Board” as described in on previous page
 - Glossary – A list of important terms and their definitions.
 - Journals – This tool is a great place to keep a journal, much like a written journal in an English class.
 - Messages – Another form of “e-mail” to use to send messages to users.
 - Send Emails – Send an email to your teacher. This tool also allows the student to send attachments.
 - Roster – Gives you a list of who is enrolled in your class and/or organization.
 - Wikis - A Wiki is a collaborative tool that allows members to contribute and modify one or more pages of Organization related materials.
- Content specific
 - *This content area will house information that is specific to this class. Items such as:*
 - Specific course related forms
 - Textbook materials
 - Lab specific items
 - Turn-it-in dropbox
 - Safe Assignment dropbox
