

Dental assistant schools can cost anywhere between \$4,000 - \$16,000. As one of our students, you can earn your Dental Assisting State Certification, your radiology certificate with the Ohio State Dental Board, and earn your CPR Certification for a fraction of the price.

Curriculum Highlights:

You will apply knowledge of anatomy, physiology, and dental terminology to educate and care for patients.

Areas of study include:

- Creating impressions and molds
- Operating X-ray machines and mounting X-rays
- Developing chair-side etiquette as part of a dental team
- Dental terminology, materials, anatomy, and physiology
- Microbiology, pathology, histology, and morphology
- CPR and First Aid
- OSHA guidelines for infection control and sterilization
- Interviewing skills, administrative procedures, and resume writing
- Prevention and patient education
- Laboratory procedures
- Chair side assisting
- Dental ethics/jurisprudence
- Pharmacology and pain control
- Radiology

Dental Assistants play an integral role on the dental team. They must be responsible, people-oriented, self-motivated, and proud of their accomplishments.

This program will prepare you to take the Ohio Dental Assistant Certification exam and the Radiology Certification test. Upon passage, you can use the Certified Ohio Dental Assistant (CODA) credential to increase your employability as a Dental Assistant.

Preference will be given to students who have successfully completed Algebra I and Biology.

I want to pursue being an oral surgeon and becoming a Dental Assistant is my first step. I can also make a good living in a profession I love while I'm in school."

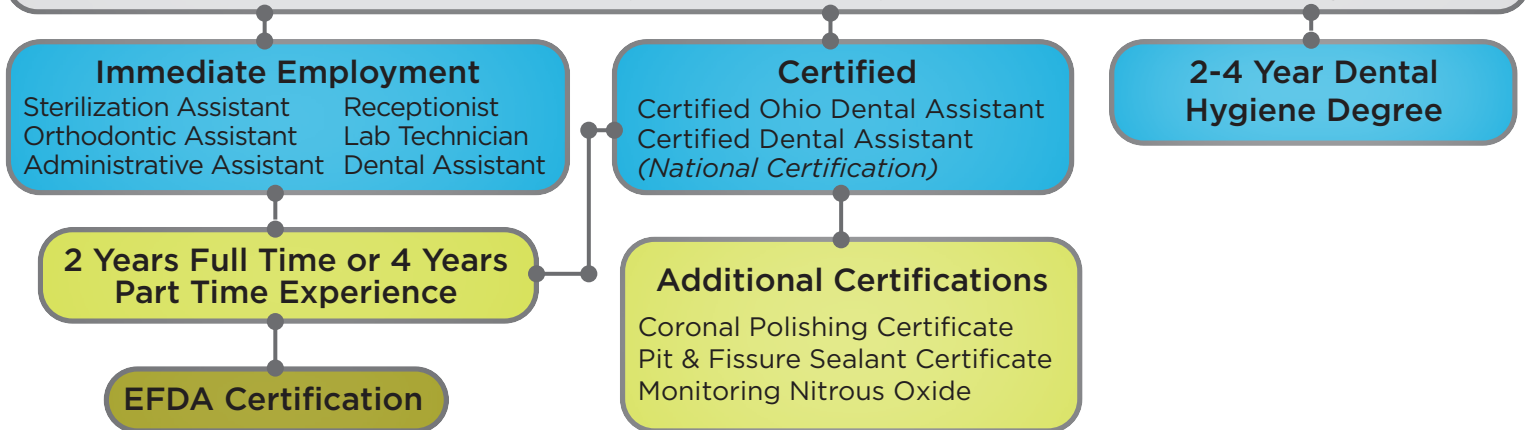
