Curriculum Highlights:

Develop the skills necessary to compete for jobs in the fields of law enforcement, corrections, and private security through realistic training and partnerships with local agencies.

Areas of study include:

- Law enforcement tactics
- Crime scene investigation and processing
- Forensic science including DNA, fingerprinting, explosives, and arson
- Corrections (jail or prison guard)
- Private security including retail and uniformed positions
- Critical incident response
- Court processes and procedures
- Criminal and civil law
- Defensive tactics
- Interview and interrogation
- Crash investigation
- Drunk driving enforcement and field sobriety testing

Career Focus:

Upon completion of our program, you will be qualified to apply for jobs in private security, corrections, or non-armed police support positions. You could choose to advance your career through military training or college. With some additional training and upon reaching age 21, you could qualify for work as a police officer, parole officer, private investigator, FBI agent, or highway patrol officer.
